

Rule Book Changes Since 2023 printing:

Section B Rule 24 e be amended as follows:

Penalty 1st Offence - The League or Tournament Official must issue a VERBAL warning to the accused participant that continued use may result in removal of the accused participant from further competition.

PENALTY 2nd Offence: The League or Tournament Official must issue a WRITTEN warning to the accused participant that continued use may result in removal of the accused participant from further competition. Removal of an individual from competition is the decision of the tournament committee.

PENALTY 3rd Offence: Removal of the participant from the competition. Bowlers shall count their score, up to and including the frame and ball in which the bowler was removed. The participant shall be reported, in writing to the Provincial Association by the League President or Tournament Director and so recorded by the Provincial 5 Pin Bowlers' Association. REPEAT OFFENDERS: Participants who are reported to the Provincial Association on two or more separate occasions, shall be liable for suspension of membership.

Rule Book – Section A, Rule 3 (a) i. be amended to read as follows:

The league has C5PBA affiliated members.

Rule Book Section A, Rule 5 be added:

Sanctioned tournaments must adhere to the following:

- a) One of the participants must be a member affiliated with the C5PBA.
- b) Lanes must be certified by a Provincial Lane Certification agent.
- c) Partial certification for record scores, perfect games, etc. will be recognized for C5PBA affiliated members.

Rule Book Section B, Rule 10 (d) add:

Any foul committed when a ball has been declared dead, will not be counted.

Rule Book Section B, Rule 26 (c) be added:

For all approved devices, please see the C5PBA Standards and Specifications manual. No modifications are allowed unless otherwise approved by the C5PBA.

Rule Book Section B Rule 4 (g) be added:

When using a mechanical aid, you must release the ball before the foul line.

Rule Book Section B Rule 13 (d) be added:

A foul is committed if the ball is not delivered before the foul line when using a mechanical device.

Rule Book Section D Rule 5 Penalty 2nd Offence add:

Removal of an individual from competition is the decision of the tournament committee.

Rule Book Section D Rule 24 Bowling Balls (use of)

Personal bowling balls must have distinguished markings with identifying letters or symbols for ball registration and identification.
